

**State Agency Information Systems:  
Reviewing Security Controls in Selected State Agencies**

Under the provisions of K.S.A. 46-1135, the Legislative Division of Post Audit conducts information technology security audits of state agencies. Every three years, we conduct a risk assessment which we then use to select agencies for review. The audits compare the selected agency's security practices to a number of the IT security standards adopted by the state's Information Technology Executive Council, as well as a handful of best practices for emerging technology issues.

This report is kept permanently confidential under K.S.A. 45-221(a)(12) because the information it contains could jeopardize the agency's IT security. No corresponding public report has been issued.
